PRODUCTION

Fermentation: 7 to 10 days at 26° C in stainless steel tanks.

Maceration: Once the vats are full, the grapes undergo a cold maceration before the alcoholic fermentation takes place.

Malolactic Fermentation: 100% Malolactic Fermentation.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Sight: A soft greenish Yellow colored wine of an impeccable transparency.

Bouquet: Wild and intense, with complex fruity layers and scent. Overtones of fruits such as grapefruit, mango, pineapple along with a tint of honey.

Mouthfeel: Velvety taste with high fineness. Long lasting with pleasant elegance.
