THE VASTNESS OF PATAGONIA DESCRIBES a boundless universe. The ancient Mapuches regarded stars as deities and the Southern Cross constellation as the footprint of a Ñandú, the sacred animal. The thousands of stars surrounding this constellation were pictured as "boleadoras" catching the Ñandú, Mapuches' sacred food. Our sky, blessed by the original civilizations, describes what only few chosen people can learn and appreciate, our Patagonian Universe.

VINEYARDS

Argentine Patagonia (39° South Latitude - 300 m.a.s.l.), Neuquén, San Patricio del Chañar, Route 7, Picada 15. Vineyard area: 162 hectares. Year of plantation: 2001. Rainfall: 197 mm/year. Temperature range: 20°C. Drip-irrigated vines on a high espalier, trained on a bilateral cordon with vertically positioned buds.

COMMENTS

15 months, French oak. Purple-colored, it displays a bouquet of cedar, cinnamon, alspice, violets, and black cherry. Medium to full-bodied, it has layered savory flavors, plenty of spice notes, good grip and depth, and a lengthy finish. Dr. Jay Miller, The Wine Advocate.

TASTING NOTES

Intense red color with purple highlights. Aromas of ripe plums and violets. On the palate, it is fruity and spicy; with hints of vanilla and caramel after being aged in French oak barrels. Elegant and well-structured wine with a long finish.
