Region: Junín-**Mendoza-Argentina** near to the Andes mountain

Old vines, pérgola system, vineyards with environmentally friendly and Sustainable production.

Mendoza is a desert, with an arid climate, where it rains very little, ideal for the quality grape plantation.

Predominant Sandy loam soil. Average height 700 meters above sea level

Irrigation with meltwater from the Andes range.

The Moscatel Amarillo and Rosado is varieties native and they belong to the family of Criolla varieties.

The harvest is done by hand, in small boxes.

Moscatel Amarillo and Moscatel Rosado

Skin contact 23 days

Fermentation and aging in concrete vessels, with native yeasts.

Natural clarification, unfiltered, small addition of sulfites and bottling.

Wine with citric characteristics, greater body and structure

Intensity and medium body.

DRY WINE, 12.40% ALCOHOL
